

All other General Regulations of the MotorsportUK's apply as written, except for the following, which are modified as follows:

Failure to drive on dipped headlight through Quiet or Neutral sections in West Mercia: Disqualification

SCRUTINEERING

All vehicles must comply with the current MSUK Technical Regulations J and R18 in addition to having a valid road fund licence, MOT and the driver must have valid insurance for use on the public highway.

Reminder, it is the competitor's responsibility to ensure vehicles confirm to the 2024 Motorsport UK Technical Regulations.

Motorsport UK Licence

Please take note that a Motorsport UK minimum level RS Interclub licence is required to compete on this event, higher grade licences are acceptable. You will not be able to apply for a licence on the night of the rally

INSURANCE

Competitors will be responsible for arranging their own insurance no blanket cover will apply on this event. Competitors will need to provide evidence of cover with their entry.

SPOTLIGHTS

For 2024 we will be trialling the use of Spotlights on Standard Sections within West Mercia with agreement of the RLO and MotorsportUK. A stipulation is competitors must use dipped headlights for Quiets and Neutral sections. Not adhering to this will result is disqualification

MARSHALLS

Due to the length of this event, we require all competing crews to supply a Marshal that is suitable equipped. Unfortunately we will need to enforce the rule of no-marshal no-start, as this is vital to secure successful running of the event.

OTHER

As this event covers 180 mile and over $6\frac{1}{2}$ hours of driving, we encourage competing crews to **rest before travelling home**.

The Knighton Hotel has offered its lounge area for people wanting a comfy seat before the long trip home.
